Studies include the assembling of statistical data, sampling techniques, measures of central tendency, dispersion, regression and correlation analysis, hypothesis testing, and probability theory. A statistical software package for data analysis will be utilized throughout the course for presentation and student project work. Prerequisites: Successful completion of MATH 0980 or eligible to enroll in MATH 1150 or higher.
