

MATH 1150 : Quantitative Reasoning II

Focuses on mathematical and statistical reasoning important for decision-making in everyday life. Integrates quantitative literacy with percentages, probability, mathematical modeling, and statistical thinking. Concepts are investigated with hands-on activities using important medical, financial, and environmental decisions examples. Communicating mathematics and using appropriate technologies will also be developed in this course.
