

NURS 2200 : Maternal-Child Nursing

This course will focus on reproductive health, conception, pregnancy, labor and delivery, newborn care, family, and health care concerns and pediatric nursing preconceptions through age 18. The student must successfully complete the course with a C+ to progress to the next clinical course in the nursing curriculum. Campus lectures and nursing skills laboratories will be required and can be assigned during day, evening and/or weekend hours. Internet assignments are required in the course. Liability insurance, lab fee, testing fee, and course fee.

Prerequisites: Successful completion of all first year Nursing courses (NURS 1200, NURS 1300, NURS 1400, NURS 1600, NURS 1650, & NURS 1675). Prerequisites or Corequisites: BIOL 2010 with a grade of C or higher.

Corequisites: NURS 2250, NURS 2275, NURS 2300. Lab fee. Course fee.
